About the EPSM:

EPSM is a non-profit trade association mainly for acquirers and other payment acceptance providers in the SEPA region.

As a non-for-profit organization, it provides a cost-effective interest representation and general information exchange on payment topics to its members.

Since its founding in April 2005, the focused EPSM has grown to more than 65 EPSM members with headquarters in 16 European countries (AT, BE, CH, CY, CZ, DE, FR, GR, HU, IE, IT, LU, LT, NL, SE, UK) and in the USA. There are voting (ordinary) members, like acquirers, payment network operators, and internet payment providers, and non-voting (extra-ordinary) members, like payment schemes, service providers, and terminal manufacturers.

In 2022 and 2023, resuming after the Corona break, there have been physical EPSM Meetings with app. 40 participants and external speakers, in Prague (Czech Republic), Munich (Germany), Milan (Italy), Frankfurt (Germany) and Zurich (Switzerland). For 2024, three physical meetings are planned. In addition, 4 virtual meetings are planned with typically 50 participants from more than 10 European countries.

Recent new members have been Toast (United States) and Castles Europe (Italy).

The association has been in contact with the European Commission, the ECB, the EBA, other European and national organisations and actively taken part in several consultations.

EPSM representatives are active in the EU Payment Systems Market Expert Group (PSMEG), the global PCI SSC Board of Advisors (PCI BoA), and in the EU Intellectual Property Observatory (EUIPO). EPSM is an observer to the European Payment Institutions Federation (EPIF).

The services for members include typically three EPSM Meetings per year with external speakers, up-todate information by e-mail, a homepage with a non-public intranet, virtual Working groups on AML Compliance, CESOP, and SCA.
